


Suspicious Website Clues

It's important to know the difference between a trustworthy website and a suspicious website. Check out this sports website and circle the six parts that are suspicious.




Do you see any of these things?

1. Lack of "https://" in the URL.
2. Misspelled words in the website text.
3. Headlines that sound questionable or untrue, also known as *clickbait*.
4. Images that don't match the text.
5. Asking for your personal information (such as your address, school, or passwords).
6. Telling you to click something for free stuff.
