






Empathy Expedition

Purpose: Understand words that will help you be a kind online explorer.

Can you find the **nine hidden words** on the map? Look up, down, across, backward, and diagonally to find words that remind you of how to stay kind online!



Search for these words that will help you practice the power of online kindness:

CONFLICT: An argument or disagreement.

CAPTION: Text that goes with a picture and provides information about what's in the photo.

BULLYING: Purposefully mean behavior that is usually repeated and meant to hurt someone.

MUTE: A way to stop seeing another person's posts and comments when you need a break from interacting with them. Unlike blocking, you're still able to visit their profile and communicate with them.

CYBERBULLYING: Bullying that happens online or through digital devices like a cell phone, tablet or laptop.

HARASSMENT: A more general word for mean behavior that can take many forms—pestering, annoying, intimidating, humiliating, and so on—and can happen online too.

EMPATHY: Trying to feel or understand what someone else is feeling.

BLOCK: A way to end contact with another person online without notifying them, to stop them from seeing your profile, sending you messages, and seeing your posts.

CONTEXT: Additional information about the photo or text that helps us understand better what we're seeing, like the time a picture was taken or the time a text was sent.
