




Message Misadventures

Purpose: Identify what a scam can look like and how to respond.

Circle what's suspicious about the conversation and the profile.



Is this person a scammer? Look for these signs:

- 1. Are they trying to get personal information from you?
- 2. Is this person a friend or someone you know in real life? Do you share mutual friends with them?
- **3.** Does their profile include some information about their identity?
- **4.** Does what they tell you match up with the information in their profile?
- 5. Has the account been active for very long?


Discussion: Pair up with a classmate and discuss what you would do if you received these messages from coolgurl23.

Answers:

- 1. The user asks you personal information (your username and password).
- 2. The user's profile has no photo or identifying information to help you know if they are telling the truth about who they are.
- **3.** You have zero mutual friends with this user even though they said you both knew someone named "Sarah."
- **4.** The user's location says they live 100 miles away. They are probably not telling the truth about living close to you.
- **5.** The user's account was created two days ago. This is a sign that it is a scammer.
