To achieve victory, you must provide each creature with three trustworthy sources of information to answer their query. For this quest, you will need a device with internet connection.



Remember how to find a trustworthy source:

1. **Check the URL.** Reliable sources often end with .edu (education institutions), .gov (government), or .org (nonprofit organization).
2. **Consider reputation.** Major news websites and online magazines usually have trustworthy information.
3. **Note the publication date and author.** Make sure information is up-to-date and the author has expertise and qualifications to be writing about the subject.
