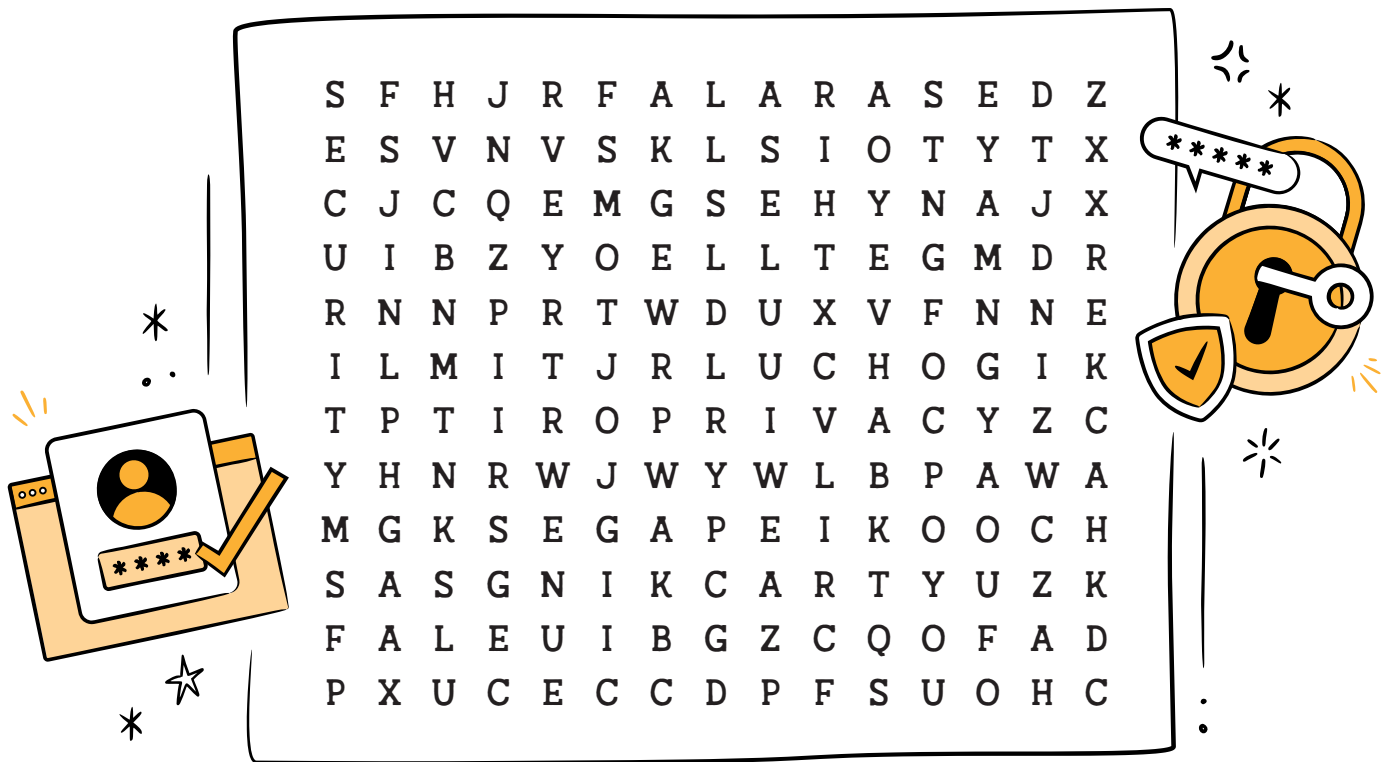


Search and Find to Secure Your Secrets

Purpose: Understand words that will help you be a strong online explorer.

Search for these words that will help you secure your secrets:

ALGORITHM: A set of instructions in software code that tells a computer, robot, etc., what to do—the way instructions on a cake mix box tell you how to make a cake.

COOKIE: Codes that track your activity on a website.

DATA: “Information” that’s digital so that it can be seen, used and shared online.

HACKER: A person who uses a computer to break into other devices without permission.

PASSWORD: A secret combination of letters, numbers and symbols used to access something.

PRIVACY: The protection of people’s data and personal information (also called sensitive information).

SECURITY: The protection of people’s devices and software.

SETTINGS: The area in any digital product, app, website, etc., where you can manage, or “set,” what you share and how your account is handled—including what you want private and what you don’t.

TRACKING: What the software of apps, sites and other online services does after they’ve placed a cookie on your device—basically, follow your activity on the internet as you go from site to site.
